Register childcare week 23

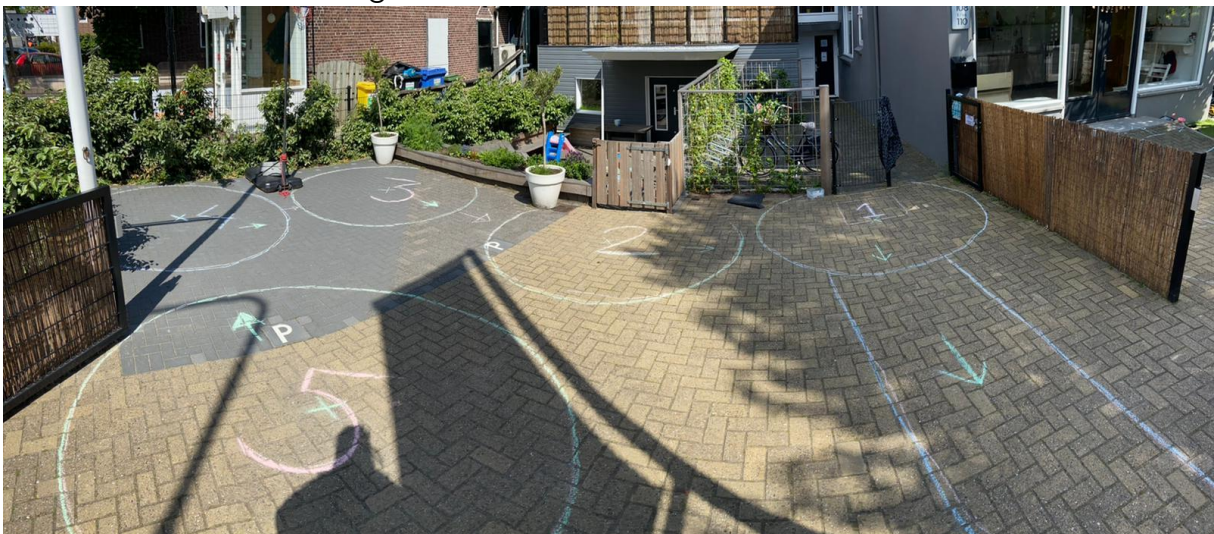
June 1 is Whit Monday and we are closed. From 2 to 5 June we still follow the school timetable. On the days that your child goes to school, your child is welcome at After School. Register your child (ren) for this week as soon as possible via administration@enjoy-amstelveen.nl

Picking up

- 1 parent comes to pick up
- We still have walking routes on site.
- Please with no more than 5 adults at the same time on the property.
- The parents walk in the open-air waiting room from circle 5 to 4 to 3 to 2 to 1. If you are in circle 1, your child will be brought to you.
- Unfortunately, we still cannot share highlights or details of the day at that time. If we or you still feel the need to call, we will do so between 6.00 - 6.30 pm via the general number of Enjoy! 020-503 6424 (choice number 2 for After School 1st floor and choice number 3 for After School basement)

Point of attention when picking up

The gate of the outdoor area is open during pick up time. On the outside area, it is the parent's responsibility to ensure that their child does not leave the area. We do not have the children in sight at those times.



Picking up several children from one family at different departments

We ask you to first pick up your oldest child at After School and then the youngest at Daycare.

Health first, a summary of the measurements at Enjoy!

- We still often wash hands, of course also after every toilet visit
- We sneeze and cough in the elbow
- We use paper towels in the kitchens and toilets
- We, team Enjoy!, keep 1.5 meters distance from each other and from you. Of course not from the children!

Also for the sake of completeness, but here is a list of what the advice from RIVM and therefore the government are. When do children stay at home?

Children with the following respiratory complaints stay at home

- Nose cold
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing / tightness

Update Chronic colds or hay fever

Children with a chronic cold should only come if they also had a chronic cold before the corona period.

Children with hay fever can come and do not need a statement from the doctor.

- Children with a fever above 38 degrees stay at home.
- Children may return to Enjoy! if they have no complaints for 24 hours.
- If everyone in the children's household has no complaints for 24 hours, the children can return to Enjoy!
- If someone in the children's household has been tested for COVID-19 and proves positive, the children should wait until that person is free of symptoms for 24 hours and then stay at home for an additional 14 days.
- When a family member has a fever above 38 degrees, everyone in the household stays at home
- If we notice the above complaints with one of the children, we will call you to ask if you will pick up your child. Good to check whether the specified emergency number is still up to date. If not, please let us know.
